

**VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT**  
**November 3, 2020 General Election**  
**Village of Blue Mounds**

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on **Tuesday, November 3, 2020** for the General Election may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. Citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on election day, and who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot.

**TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR MUNICIPAL CLERK.**

You must submit your request in writing, whether it be by email, letter, or filling out the request form. Your written request must list your name, voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and the date of the election(s) you are requesting your ballot for. **YOU MUST ALSO PROVIDE YOUR PHOTO ID.**

Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk.

You can also personally go to the clerk's office to vote an absentee ballot. **YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR PHOTO ID TO RECEIVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT.**

**THE DEADLINE FOR MAKING APPLICATION TO VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL IS 5:00 P.M., ON THE THURSDAY BEFORE THE ELECTION, OCTOBER 29, 2020.**

**SPECIFIC IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING TIMES ARE STATED BELOW STARTING TUESDAY, OCTOBER 20, 2020 AND ENDING AT 5PM FRIDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2020.**

**ALL VOTED BALLOTS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE MUNICIPAL CLERK SO THE CLERK CAN DELIVER THEM TO THE PROPER POLLING PLACE BEFORE THE POLLS CLOSE ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020 THE DAY OF THE ELECTION. BALLOTS WILL NOT BE COUNTED IF THEY ARE RECEIVED AFTER 8:00PM ON ELECTION DAY.**
